Motion/second Dahlquist/Hollands to approve the January 4th, 2021 agenda. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.

Motion/second Hollands/Dahlquist to approve minutes of the regular town board meeting of December 21st, 2020. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.
