Motion/second Dahlquist/Cates to approve the October 9^{th,} 2023, agenda. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.

Motion/second Cates/Hollands to approve minutes of the regular town board meeting of September 25^{th,} 2023. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.

15 Minutes of informal public comments- 15 Residents came to ask why the curbs were painted yellow for no parking on Faust Lake Rd beside Wayne's Place. Questions about what changed and why now were asked. Chairman Hollands told them that no parking sings used to be up but kept disappearing. Chairman Hollands also said it was for safety and that we had received complaints. The Town Board agreed to let the residents paint the portion from the side door of Wayne's Place and North white until Chairman Hollands could do more research on it.

Library reports were handed out and questions were asked why the Town of Pelican requested arbitration. Clerk Ring explained that the library was asking for 47% (\$4463) of the \$9470 that the Town's portion of taxes were going up.

The Board reviewed the first proposal of budget. No discussion at this time.
