MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
MARCH 14TH, 2022

Roll call: Present were Chairman Gerald Rouou, Supervisors Walter Dahlquist and Dave Hollands, Constable James Cates, and Treasurer Cindy Carroll.

Motion/second Dahlquist/Hollands to approve the March 14th, 2022, agenda. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.

Motion/second Hollands/Dahlquist to approve minutes of the regular town board meeting of February 28th, 2022. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.

15 Minutes of informal public comments –

Motion/second Dahlquist/Hollands to hire MSA Professional Service to help with State grants. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.

Motion/second Dahlquist/Hollands to allow snowmobile trail to run an extra mile of Haymeadow for 2 years. The side of road will be brushed out to help keep the snowmobiles off the road as much as possible. Town can revoke permission at any point.

Motion/second Hollands/Dahlquist to allow snowmobile to run River End, Berquist Rd, cross Laura Ln and Beaver Creek when current 2-year agreement runs out.

Motion/second Dahlquist/Hollands to allow Oneida Co forestry dept and the Hodag Sno Trails to build a bridge across the Pelican River connecting Rivers End and Berquist Rd.

Motion/second Dahlquist/Hollands to approve resolution 2022-01 on Broadband. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.

Motion/second Dahlquist/Hollands to pay vouchers 9472–9495 in the amount of \$26,825.22 All aye on voice vote and motion carried.

Motion/second Hollands/Dahlquist accept the treasurer's report as presented. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.

Motion/second Dahlquist/Hollands to adjourn at 5:14 p.m. All aye on voice vote and motion carried.
