ORDINANCE #1.2023

ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE CLASS B HIGHWAYS

STATE OF WISCONSIN TOWN OF PELICAN ONEIDA COUNTY

The Town Board of the Town of Pelican, Oneida County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under State Statute 349.15(2), to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by the majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates the town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:

A. The following town highways in the Town of Pelican are designated class 'B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in State Statute 348.16(2) unless increased by town ordinance:

- 1. Faust Lake Rd 1650 feet south from intersection of North Shore Dr.
- B. The town chairperson, or his/her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-mentioned highways in violation of the weight limits set forth in State Statute 348.16(2). Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$100.00, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes as separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective on 19th of June, 2023.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under State Statute 84.02(4)(e).
