The Town Board of the Town of Pelican do ordain as follows:

That all existing ordinances and regulations contrary hereto are hereby repealed and more specifically an ordinance adopted December 9, 1974 (a) The Clerk is directed to post a copy of this ordinance at published December 13, 1974 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1 - No person may operate a motor boat within a buoyed restricted area on Lake Thompson at a speed in excess of slow-no-wake. Definition of Buoyed Restricted Area: The area lying within and between slowno-wake buoys.

SECTION 2 - Designated Restricted Area on Lake Thompson.

(a) Description of real estate in front of which buoys are to be placed:

> Section 2, Township 36 North, Range 9 East. Lot 15 of the Plat of the First Addition to Pinewood Lodge.

(b) Type of Marker and Location: Slow-no-wake buoys to be placed as follows: (1) One at 100' Southeast of dock and 50' South 35° West of shore line. (2) One at 100' Northwest of dock and 100' South 35° West of shore line (3) One at 125! South 35° West of Southwest end of dock. (4) One within 10' of Southwest end of dock.

SECTION 3 - Penalties. Any person violating the provisions herei shall upon conviction thereof forfeit a sum not exceeding \$50 together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned in the county jail until full payment thereof is made, but not exceeding 30 days for the first offense, or forfeit a sum not to exceed \$100 together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned in county jail until full payment thereof is made, but not exceeding 90 days upor

conviction of the same offense, a second or subsequent time within one year.
