THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Town of Pelican establish wards conforming to the County Supervisory Plan (see attached) and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, that for all voting purposes, the above ward(s) will be combined, using one common polling place, which is the Pelican Town Hall located at 4094 Co Hwy P.


